SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 953, filed October 20, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide temporary additional gas service in excess of 200 Mcfd to Great Basins Petroleum Company, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the average amount of gas needed will be 250 Mcfd and the peak demand will be 432 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer plans to drill an oil well in Kern County with the use of four gas engines which cannot be reasonably converted to use an alternate fuel, and

WHEREAS: The gas service will be provided for a temporary period from October, 1975 to January, 1976 under Gas Engine Schedule G-45, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested temporary natural gas service to Great Basins Petroleum Company, effective November 19, 1975, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1829.
