SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Offset Increase in Gas Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 72-G, filed August 29, 1975, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code and under the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause in its filed tariffs, to adjust its gas rate schedules, applicable to its Needles rate area, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 396-G to 400-G, inclusive, to become effective October 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: These tariff revisions are to offset changes in rates filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company by Advice Letter No. 738-G and which became effective on August 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: California-Pacific Utilities Company was granted a Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure by Decision No. 84765, dated August 5, 1975, in Application No. 54665, and

WHEREAS: It is proposed to increase existing tariffs by 2.786 cents per therm, resulting in an addition to current annual revenues of \$27,893, which will directly offset the increased cost of gas from PG&E, and

WHEREAS: We find that this rate increase is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted in accordance with the provisions of California-Pacific's Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure and under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective for service on and after October 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1830.
