RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Revisions on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 73-G, filed September 24, 1975, requests authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause in its filed tariffs, to adjust its gas rate schedules, applicable to its Needles rate area, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 401-G to 404-G, inclusive, to become effective on October 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: Those tariff revisions are to offset changes in rates filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company by Advice Letter No. 758-G, which became effective on September 21, 1975, and by Advice Letter No. 759-G, which will become effective on October 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: The two filings combine an increase and a decrease in rates resulting in a net rate increase for California-Pacific of 0.375 cents per therm, resulting in an addition to current annual revenues of \$3,759, which will directly offset the revised cost of gas from PG&E, and

WHEREAS: Short-notice authorization is requested to coincide with PG&E's rate reduction, and

WHEREAS: PG&E's rate increase is already in effect, and

WHEREAS: We find that this rate revision is justified, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted in accordance with California-Pacific's Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure and under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above tariff sheets effective for service on and after October 1, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1831.
