> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing PGA Offset in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Required Notice

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 75-G, filed November 3, 1975, requests authority under the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clause in its filed tariffs, and under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to adjust its gas rates applicable to its Needles, California rate area as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 408-G thru 411-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: These increases are to offset changes in rates filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company in Advice Letter 764-G, pursuant to Decision No. 84082, in Application No. 55687, which became effective November 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: It is requested to increase existing tariffs by .868 cents per therm resulting in an addition to current annual revenue of \$8,685, and

WHEREAS: California-Pacific requests a waiver of the 30 day notification requirement of its PGA clause in order to make this filing effective as soon as possible to offset the PG&E rate increase already in effect, and

WHEREAS: We find that this rate increase is reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted in accordance with the provision of the utility's PGA procedure and under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above tariff sheets effective for service rendered on and after November 12, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1833.
