> SUBJECT: Request to Provide Temporary Interruptible Natural Gas Service Under Special Contract on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 765-G, filed November 6, 1975, having requested Commission approval to provide temporary interruptible natural gas service to One Market Plaza in San Francisco, and

WHEREAS: The amount of gas provided which will be in excess of 200 Mcfd, has already been approved by Resolution G-1817, on a temporary basis, with said agreement to terminate on October 1, 1976, and

WHEREAS: The contract complies with the provisions of Rules 13 and 21, and Schedule G-50 of the utility's filed tariff schedules, and

WHEREAS: Approval on less than statutory notice is requested under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code in order that the customer may receive natural gas as soon as possible, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section X.A. of General Order No. 96-A and Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to supply the requested temporary interruptible natural gas service to One Market Plaza, effective November 25, 1975.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1835.
