SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 757-G, filed September 16, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 83819 to provide additional interruptible gas service to V. P. Corn Products, Inc., at customer's plant in Madera County, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of additional gas needed is 160 Mcfd for a total peak demand of 420 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional fuel for direct process of food products, and

WHEREAS: The customer has indicated alternate fuel storage capacity for 20,000 gallons of propane, and

WHEREAS: Non-gaseous fuels cannot be used as alternate fuel as they will contaminate the food products, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 83819 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested interruptible natural gas service to V. P. Corn Products, Inc., effective October 16, 1975, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1836.
