> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of Rule 14, Rendering of Bills -Gas Service, on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 346-G, filed November 18, 1975, requests authority under Section V.B. of General Order No. 96-A to make effective a revision of Rule 14, Rendering of Bills - Gas Service, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1943-G, 1944-G and 1945-G, on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: Said revision will allow San Diego Gas and Electric to implement a pilot program covering its National City District, wherein it will read all residential gas meters at regular bi-monthly intervals, while it will continue billing at monthly intervals, and

WHEREAS: The remainder of San Diego Gas and Electric's customers will remain unchanged on meter reading and billing intervals until the pilot program is completed and evaluated, and

WHEREAS: Said pilot program should be completed and evaluated by San Diego Gas and Electric and a report to the Commission made no later than June 30, 1976, and

WHEREAS: Bi-monthly reading of meters can be continued and expanded under Rule 14 revision without further change of the rule, and

WHEREAS: Said revision of Rule 14 will not increase any rate or charge, conflict with other schedules or rules, or cause withdrawal of service; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1943-G to 1945-G, inclusive, be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution No. G-1839 of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California, to become effective December 2, 1975.
