SUBJECT: Request to Continue to Provide Interruptible Natural Gas Service At a New Location

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 767-G, filed December 15, 1975, having requested Commission approval to continue to provide interruptible natural gas service to Spaich Brothers at a new location, and

WHEREAS: Spaich Brothers has moved its existing prune dehydrators from San Jose to Live Oak and will not have any new additional equipment, and

WHEREAS: PG&E states that Spaich Brothers' past usage of natural gas has been greater than 200 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: We find this request in change of location of service in compliance with the intent of Decision No. 83819; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective on January 14, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
