SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increase for LPG Price Change

WHEREAS: LAKE COUNTY UTILITY COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 19, filed December 17, 1975, having requested authority under its fuel escalation clauses to offset an LPG purchase price increase, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 73-G and 74-G, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue increase of \$1,650 is offset by the estimated \$1,650 increase in annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: The Commission staffhas testified in C-9988 to a lifeline winter usage of 125 therms per month to April 30, 1976, and

WHEREAS: The utility has advised that customer usage per month is less than this quantity.

THE COMMISSION FINDS: For the purpose of this filing, the interim lifeline quantity of gas to be 125 therms per month, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS: That the customer usage is less than 125 therms per month, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS: That the rate increase should apply to all customers on an interim basis, and

THE COMMISSION FINDS: That this filing adheres to the utility's fuel escalation clauses, and in this respect is justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 701 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for meter readings on or after January 14, 1976, and that such increase is to be on an interim basis, until April 30, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1847.
