SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Decrease in Rates on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC CO., by Advice Letter No. 350-G, filed January 13, 1976, requests authority to decrease rates pursuant to the tracking provisions of its Purchased Gas Adjustment Procedure to reflect a decrease in the North Alaska Funding Adjustment (NAFA) rates from SoCal Gas Co., as set forth in Cal P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1972-G through 1982-G inclusive, and

WHEREAS: San Diego Gas & Electric Co. further requests authority to make the rate reductions therein effective on less than statutory notice under Section 491 of the P.U.C. Code, and

WHEREAS: The reduction and removal of the NAFA rate adjustment is in compliance with the intent of this Commission, and

WHEREAS: The rate reduction will reduce annual revenues to San Diego by approximately \$2,528,300, and

WHEREAS: Instituting this rate reduction at the earliest possible date is in the best interests of the ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision Nos. 85113 and 85183 to make the rate reduction in the above tariff sheets effective for service on and after January 13, 1976,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of California No. G-1849,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that San Diego Gas & Electric Co. will file with this Commission, within 20 days, a refund plan to refund the amounts already collected in rates.
