SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Annual Zoning Reduction

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 768-G, filed January 14, 1976, requests authority under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code and pursuant to the provisions of Decision No. 56967, to place into effect annual zoning reductions, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 9759-G to 9781-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revisions to rate zone boundaries will provide an estimated annual revenue reduction of \$30,000 applicable to a total of 2,848 general service customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective as of February 1, 1976.
