RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
 Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 964, filed December 23, 1975, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189 to provide interruptible gas service in excess of 50 Mcfd to Grefco, Inc., to produce rigid roof insulation, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the average amount of gas demand is 2,218 Mcfd and a peak load of 3,854 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: An alternative fuel such as oil cannot be used because of the damage to the equipment and the resulting unacceptable quality of the product caused by the chemical reaction, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested interruptible natural gas service to Grefco, Inc., effective February 10, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1852.
