RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Amendment to Contract Previously Approved

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 769-G, filed January 30, 1976, having requested authorization under Section X. A. of the General Order No. 96-A to amend a contract between it and the City of Santa Clara, the City of Sunnyvale and Sequoia Pacific Realco for gas service, and

WHEREAS: This contract was originally submitted to the Commission by Advice Letter No. 698-G and approved by Resolution No. G-1726 on March 1, 1975, and

WHEREAS: The amendment, which is between only Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Sequoia Pacific Realco, allows for the possible transfer of Sequoia's obligation under the basic agreement to its successors in interest or third parties upon sale of all or portion of the property involved, and

WHEREAS: The contract remains the same as previously approved in all other ways; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under Section X. A. of General Order No. 96-A for the amendment to the contract between Pacific Gas and Electric Company and the City of Santa Clara, the City of Sunnyvale and Sequoia Pacific Realco be accepted for filing effective March 2, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and amendment to the contract be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1855.
