SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 771-G, filed February 2, 1976, having requested approval under Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 85189, to continue the present level of interruptible natural gas service to existing prune drying equipment under the new ownership of Didar S. Bains, and

WHEREAS: Continuation of existing service under new ownership with no increase in the level of demand is not considered a "new customer" within the meaning of the term as used in Paragraphs 3 and 4 of Decision No. 85189; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested interruptible natural gas service to Didar S. Bains, effective February 18, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above filing be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1856.
