SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Refund Plan

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by letter filed February 2, 1976, having requested authority to place its Northern Alaska Funding Adjustment (NAFA) Refund Plan into effect during April, 1976, and

WHEREAS: This plan was submitted pursuant to Resolution No. G-1848, and

WHEREAS: The proposed plan reflects funds that were collected under the previously authorized NAFA procedures during the period from December 7, 1975 to January 12, 1976, and

WHEREAS: The preliminary estimates indicate the refund amount to be approximately \$3,800,000 and interest to be approximately \$26,000, and

WHEREAS: The refund will be based on the gas usage of each customer during the period NAFA was in effect, and

WHEREAS: The utility desires to credit such refund to each customer's April, 1976 bill, and

WHEREAS: We find that this method of refund is acceptable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company be granted authority to place the NAFA Refund Plan into effect commencing March 9, 1976, for crediting on the customer's April, 1976 bill.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company shall keep records of the refunds made and shall submit reports on the disposition of any amounts unrefunded by September 30, 1976.
