SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 772-G, filed February 24, 1976, having requested approval under Ordering Paragraph 3 of Decision No. 85189 to provide interruptible gas service in excess of 50 Mcfd to the City of Santa Rosa's Laguna Wastewater Treatment Plant, and

WHEREAS: The gas to be provided is to be mixed with gas produced in the treatment plant digestors and used in gas engines, and

WHEREAS: The use of alternative prime movers, such as deisel engines or electric motors, could result in the waste of approximately 150 Mcf per day of gas produced in the plant digestors, therefore; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to provide the requested gas service to the City of Santa Rosa's Laguna Wastewater Treatment Plant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1859.
