**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by  
Southern California Gas Company

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 970, filed February 20, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to provide additional natural gas service in excess of 50 Mcfd to Sun-Maid Raisins, Inc., and

**WHEREAS:** Sun-Maid requires natural gas for its raisin drying process, and

**WHEREAS:** The customer states that the amount of gas usage will increase from 175 Mcfd to 720 Mcfd, and

**WHEREAS:** The customer cannot use fuel oil since combustion products would come in contact with the raisins and would result in an unacceptable product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested additional gas service to Sun-Maid Raisins, Inc., effective March 21, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1860.
