SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Decrease in Rates on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: CALIFORNIA-PACIFIC UTILITIES COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 78-G, filed March 17, 1976, requests authority to decrease its gas rate schedules as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 418-G to 420-G, inclusive, on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The requested decrease is based on the decrease in cost of gas from its supplier, Southwest Gas Corporation, and

WHEREAS: Authority for California-Pacific Utilities Company to track changes in the cost of gas is set forth in the Ordering Paragraph of Decision No. 84006, and

WHEREAS: The total net revenue effect of this requested filing will result in an approximate decrease of \$88,400 in annual revenue; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above tariff sheets effective for service on April 1, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were accepted for filing under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1869.
