SUBJECT: Request to Reconnect Natural Gas Service by
Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 774-G, filed March 15, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to reconnect and supply natural gas service in excess of 50 Mcfd to Fat City Feedlots, Inc., and

WHEREAS: Fat City was supplied gas service for use as boiler fuel under Firm Industrial Schedule No. G-40 through July, 1975, when it incurred financial trouble, and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of gas usage will be 114 Mcfd, which is the same amount as previous usages, and

WHEREAS: Fat City utilizes the steam generated in the boilers to process feed for approximately 80,000 head of cattle, and

WHEREAS: There are no alternative fuel facilities present due to the fact that Fat City has historically been provided with firm service; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Fat City Feedlots, Inc., effective April 14, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1870.
