WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 781-G, filed March 13, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to John W. Saunders & Sons, Inc., and

WHEREAS: The customer states that the amount of gas needed is 18,000 Mcf during the months of August and September at the rate of 340 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this gas in the operation of nine new direct fired tunnel dehydrators for drying prunes, and

WHEREAS: It is not possible to use fuel oil for direct fired drying of prunes without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to John W. Saunders & Sons, Inc., effective May 4, 1976.
