WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 778-G, filed March 19, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Fruehauf Corporation, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in gas-fired unit heaters and a paint finishing system, and

WHEREAS: There is no practical, economic alternative to using natural gas, and

WHEREAS: The installed unit heaters and painting system cannot use fuel oil; therefore, good cause appearing,
