WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 785-G, filed May 3, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Kromberg Bros. and Sahatdjian Bros., and

WHEREAS: The applicants will consume 24,192 Mcf per month during the months of August, September, October and November for an average daily requirement of 806 Mcf per day in 14 new direct-fired raisin drying tunnels, and

WHEREAS: It is not possible to use fuel oil in this process without contamination of the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Kromberg Bros. and Sahatdjian Bros. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1883.
