WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 786-G, filed May 5, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas service in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Roberts Farms, Inc., and

WHEREAS: Applicant has installed two additional prune dryer tunnels, and

WHEREAS: The new total gas requirement will be 336 Mcf per day, and

WHEREAS: Alternate fuel cannot be used in these direct-fired dryer tunnels; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Roberts Farms, Inc., effective June 4, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
