SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 788-G, filed May 5, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to the Lodi Unified High School District for its rebuilt Tokay High School, and

WHEREAS: The former high school, which had a peak demand of 108 Mcf per day under firm gas service, was burned down by vandals, and

WHEREAS: The new high school will have a peak demand of 78 Mcf per day, a reduction of 28%, and

WHEREAS: This application is considered a restoration of firm service rather than a request for new service, and

WHEREAS: Under these circumstances and the end-use criteria established by Decision No. 85189, the applicant would be classified as Priority 1; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to the Lodi Unified High School District, effective June 4, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1889. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
