SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 789-G, filed May 5, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Delta Grain Company, and

WHEREAS: Delta Grain Company will use this gas in direct-fired gas corn dryer, and

WHEREAS: Delta Grain Company states the operation will be seasonal during September, October and November with maximum average usage of 240 Mcf per day occuring in October, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in the corn dryer; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Delta Grain, effective June 4, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1890. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
