WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 790-G, filed May 5, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Consolidated Fiber Glass Products Company, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in a direct-fired industrial oven used in curing fiberglass mat, a basic ingredient used by the applicant in the production of roofing materials, and

WHEREAS: The average daily gas consumption will be 158 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in these direct-fired ovens; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Consolidated Fiber Glass Products Company, effective June 4, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.
