**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 790-G, filed May 5, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Consolidated Fiber Glass Products Company, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will use this gas in a direct-fired industrial oven used in curing fiberglass mat, a basic ingredient used by the applicant in the production of roofing materials, and

**WHEREAS:** The average daily gas consumption will be 158 Mcf, and

**WHEREAS:** Fuel oil cannot be used in these direct-fired ovens; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Consolidated Fiber Glass Products Company, effective June 4, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1891. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
