SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service on Less Than Statutory Notice by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 979, filed May 11, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to C. E. Jones Ceramics, Inc. at their new location, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this gas at an estimated peak day demand of 130 Mcf in direct-fired envelope type kilns to fire ceramic art forms, and

WHEREAS: Oil cannot be used to fire these kilns without damaging the color quality of the art forms, and

WHEREAS: The advice letter requests this filing be made effective under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code on less than statutory notice for the reason that the customer's plant is scheduled for operation pending Commission approval; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code and the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to C. E. Jones Ceramics, Inc., effective this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1892. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
