SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increase for LPG Price Change and Establishment of "Lifeline" Rate Structure as Previously Approved

WHEREAS: ROLLING GREEN UTILITIES, INC., by Advice Letter No. 20-G, filed May 10, 1976, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 739 of the Public Utilities Code to offset an LPG purchase price increase and to file revised tariff schedules, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 89-G to 91-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The revised rate schedule establishes lifeline quantities as previously approved by Commission Resolution No. G-1876, dated April 27, 1976, and

WHEREAS: The estimated annual revenue increase of \$1,200 is offset by the estimated \$1,200 increase in annual fuel expense, and

WHEREAS: The utility has been bearing the increased cost of fuel without a rate increase for almost five months, and

WHEREAS: We find the rate increase to be reasonable and the new rate structure to comply with the will and intent of Section 739 of the Public Utilities Code; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 739 of the Public Utilities Code to make this filing effective for meter readings taken on or after this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1893. The effective date of this resolution is the date hereof.
