SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 792-G, filed May 19, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas service in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Lion Packing Company, and

WHEREAS: This gas will be used to operate 12 direct-fired drying tunnels, with an average daily consumption of 720 Mcf, to dry grapes during the months of August to November, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in these dryers without product contamination; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Lion Packing Company, effective June 18, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1896. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
