SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 983, filed May 26, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Peloian Ranches, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in direct-fired raisin dryers at a peak demand of 545 Mcfd during the months of August through November, and

WHEREAS: Alternate fuel cannot be used in these direct-fired dryers, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests that this filing be made effective under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code on less than statutory notice for the reason that Applicant has a critical timing problem for the purchase and installation of this equipment prior to the operating season beginning in August; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 in Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Peloian Ranches, effective this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1897. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
