SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 986, filed May 26, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Hickman Dehydrator, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in six direct-fired prune dryers at a peak demand of 216 Mcfd during the months of August and September, and

WHEREAS: Alternate fuel cannot be used in these direct-fired tunnels, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests that this filing be made effective under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code on less than the statutory notice for the reason that main and service extensions will have to be made before the drying season begins in August; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code and under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Hickman Dehydrator, effective this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1899. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
