SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 794-G, filed May 27, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Gulzar S. Johl, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in nine direct-fired prune dryers at an average rate of 338 Mcfd during the months of August and September, and

WHEREAS: Alternate fuel cannot be used in these direct-fired dryer tunnels without contamination to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Gulzar S. Johl, effective June 26, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1900. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
