SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 795-G, filed May 27, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to San Francisco Hilton Inn, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional natural gas in cooking equipment and in domestic type water heaters, and

WHEREAS: Applicants's new average daily load will increase from 86 Mcf to 109 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Alternate fuel cannot be used in this direct process end-use, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas & Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to San Francisco Hilton Inn, effective June 26, 1976, which constitutes regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1901. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
