Reconsideration of Denial by Pacific Gas & Electric Company
For Additional Gas ServiceWHEREAS: SANTA CRUZ CANNING COMPANY, by letter dated April 27, 1976, having
requested Commission reconsideration of the denial by PG&E to supply additional
natural gas, and

WHEREAS: The additional amount of gas requested is 70 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: This gas will be used to operate a fume incinerator in an anchovy
drying process in the manufacture of chicken feed, andWHEREAS: The anchovy operation provides seasonal employment for 25 people
plus 6 fishing vessels from 3 to 5 months of the year, andWHEREAS: Santa Cruz Canning Company requests this gas service until
December, 1977, by which time a decision will be made to renovate the plant or
close it, andWHEREAS: If the plant is to be renovated, the fume incinerator will be
converted to fuel oil; therefore, good cause appearing,IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision
No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested additional gas service to Santa Cruz
Canning Company until December 31, 1977. The effective date of this Resolution is
