**SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by  
Pacific Gas & Electric Company**

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 798-G, filed June 2, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Banquet Foods Corporation, and

WHEREAS: The customer will use this additional gas in a direct-fired meat broiler in his frozen food operation, and

WHEREAS: The average daily consumption will increase by 11 Mcf, from 764 Mcf to 775 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without contamination of the food product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested gas service to Banquet Foods, Inc., effective July 2, 1976.


