SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by  
Pacific Gas & Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 801-G,  
filed June 7, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision  
No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day  
to Sunsweet Dryers (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in six new prune dryer tunnels, and

WHEREAS: The amount requested will average 190 Mcfd raising the existing  
consumption from 948 Mcfd to 1,138 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in these direct-fired dryer tunnels;  
therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of  
Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested additional gas service  
to Sunsweet Dryers effective July 7, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to  
show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities  
Commission of the State of California No. G-1912. The effective date of  
this Resolution is the date hereof.
