**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service  
by Pacific Gas & Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 802-G, filed June 7, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Nunes Ranch (Applicant), and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will use this gas in two new prune dryer tunnels, and

**WHEREAS:** The amount requested will average 75 Mcfd raising the existing consumption from 188 Mcfd to 263 Mcfd, and

**WHEREAS:** Fuel oil cannot be used in these direct-fired tunnels; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested gas service to Nunes Ranch effective July 7, 1976.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1913. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
