SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 803-G, filed June 14, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to B & M Ranch (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 40 Mcf, raising the existing average daily consumption from 11 Mcf to 51 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in the direct-fired walnut dryer without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to B & M Ranch effective July 14, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1914. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
