SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 985, filed May 26, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Guardian Industries (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicants request is for a peak day demand of 115 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this natural gas for human comfort infra-red space and domestic type hot water heaters, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in the types of equipment proposed by the applicant; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Guardian Industries, effective July 13, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1917. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
