WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 991, filed June 17, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Airesearch Manufacturing Company • (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional peak consumption of 210 Mcfd, raising his existing peak consumption from 10 Mcfd to 220 Mcfd, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to test and demonstrate the performance of gas turbines being developed for use on the Arctic gas pipeline, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used since the on-site fuel will be natural gas; therefore, good cause appearing

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the additional requested gas service to Airesearch Manufacturing Company, effective July 17, 1976, which constitute regular statutory notice.
