RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 992, filed June 24, 1976, having requested Commission approval under Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Norris Industries (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 114 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas to operate two wall type space heaters, two domestic type water heaters and two paint bake ovens, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in the above equipment, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests that this filing be made effective under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code on less than the statutory notice for the reason that Applicant is in the process of closing escrow for the new plant; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utility Code and the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Norris Industries, effective July 13, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1921. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
