**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by  
 Pacific Gas & Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 784-G, filed May 3, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Pacific Galvanizing (Applicant), and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 50 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 42 Mcf to 92 Mcf, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will use this additional gas to operate a hot dip galvanizing kettle, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will buy out and close down a competitor who presently uses 100 Mcfd, resulting in a net decrease of 50 Mcfd on the PG&E system; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for PG&E to supply the requested gas service to Pacific Galvanizing, effective this date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1922. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
