SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 997, filed
July 8, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of
Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to
C. J. Shannon & Sons (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas in a direct-fired grain dryer at an
average daily rate of 110 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: The dryer in question is not capable of burning fuel oil but is
the most efficient for the purpose intended; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision
No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas
service to C. J. Shannon & Sons effective August 7, 1976, which constitutes
regular statutory notice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter be marked to show that
it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of
the State of California No. G-1927. The effective date of this Resolution
is the date hereof.
