> SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1000, filed July 16, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcfd to Atlantic Richfield Company (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 75 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 26 Mcf to 101 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to power two existing gas fueled crude oil pumping units, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used for this application, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the additional requested gas service to Atlantic Richfield Company, effective August 15, 1976.
