**SUBJECT:** Request for Review of Gas Service Denial to Tony's Nurseries by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** Tony's Nurseries, by letter dated July 27, 1976 and filed July 29, 1976, has requested the Commission to review gas service denial by PG&E, and

**WHEREAS:** The denial was in compliance with Decision No. 85189 since the gas requested would be used as boiler fuel, would amount to a peak of 80 Mcfd, and since fuel oil can be used for this application, and

**WHEREAS:** Except for a series of personal and financial calamities beyond their control, Tony's Nurseries would have been a firm customer since 1973, and

**WHEREAS:** All the plans, arrangements and commitments were made two years prior to the effective date of Decision No. 85189; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that PG&E be ordered to provide the requested gas service to Tony's Nurseries under Priority 1, as defined in Decision No. 85189, effective August 17, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above letter and Tony's Nurseries' application be marked to show that gas service was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1934. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
