WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1005, filed August 9, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Miali Pottery (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 30 Mcf, raising his existing average daily consumption from 59 Mcf to 89 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to operate a new direct-fired envelope type pottery kiln at his new location, having moved the two existing pottery kilns to the new location, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this application without damage to the product; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Company to supply the requested gas service to Miali Pottery, effective September 8, 1976.
