SUBJECT: Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by
 Southern California Gas Company

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 1006, filed August 8, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to the City of Los Angeles (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an initial average daily consumption of 85 Mcf for about one month and then 60 cfh thereafter, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this gas initially to start up its Terminal Island Treatment Plant, Unit II until it can produce its own methane, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil can be used to start up the operation, it would be unreasonable to require the City of Los Angeles to do so for a one month period; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Southern California Gas Co. to supply the requested gas service to the City of Los Angeles, effective September 8, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1941. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
