SUBJECT: Request to Provide Additional Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 812-G, filed August 12, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply additional natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Kromberg Bros. & Sahatjian Bros., (Applicant), and

WHEREAS: Applicant's request is for an additional average daily consumption of 230 Mcf, raising his existing daily consumption from 806 Mcf to 1,036 Mcf, and

WHEREAS: Applicant will use this additional gas to operate four, direct-fired tunnel fruit dryers, and

WHEREAS: Fuel oil cannot be used in this process without contaminating the food product; therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under the provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Kromberg Bros. & Sahatjian Bros., effective September 14, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1950. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
