**SUBJECT:** Request to Provide Natural Gas Service by Pacific Gas and Electric Company

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 813-G, filed August 12, 1976, having requested Commission approval under the provisions of Decision No. 85189, to supply natural gas in excess of 50 Mcf per day to Pengo Corporation (Applicant), and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant's request is for an average daily consumption of 104 Mcf, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant will use this gas to operate a steel forging and heat treating plant at a new location, having consolidated his operations from two locations to one new one, and

**WHEREAS:** Applicant was a firm customer at the old location, and

**WHEREAS:** The consolidation will amount to a reduction in total gas consumption; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under provisions of Decision No. 85189 for Pacific Gas and Electric Company to supply the requested gas service to Pengo Corporation, effective September 14, 1976.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above advice letter and application be marked to show that they were authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1951. The effective date of this Resolution is the date hereof.
